The past presidents and current president and first vice-president may hold a meeting following the end of the outgoing president's term in office, which is usually two years. The new president will select the time and place and notify the past presidents.

Club objectives, mission statements and long range planning should be reviewed and suggestions for changes or refocusing made. Input should be sought from all present and notes taken and filed in the secretary's book for safekeeping and easy access.
